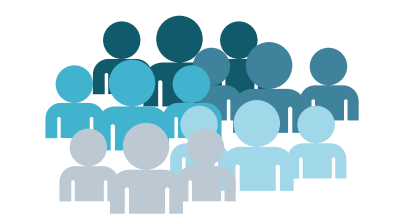


# Who is Elekta PAC?

### Elekta PAC Structure



The Elekta PAC Board meets once per quarter and makes all decisions for the PAC by a majority vote.



The Elekta PAC Manager engages with PAC Members and orchestrates PAC operations.



The Elekta PAC Treasurer controls PAC funds and keeps the PAC financial records in order.
